

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALL MEETING  
OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
OF THE CITY OF STARKVILLE, MISSISSIPPI  
NOVEMBER 22, 2022 AT 10:00 A.M.**

Be it remembered that the Vice-Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in a Special Call Meeting on November 22, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Second Floor Conference Room of City Hall, located at 110 West Main Street, Starkville, MS. Present were Vice-Mayor Roy A'. Perkins, Aldermen Sandra Sistrunk, Jeffrey Rupp, Mike Brooks, Hamp Beatty and Henry Vaughn, Sr., as well as City Clerk Lesa Hardin. Attorney Chris Latimer appeared by video conference.

The meeting was properly noticed pursuant to Miss. Code Ann §21-3-21 and a copy of that notice is included in the minutes. The public and media were welcomed and attended.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 21-3-21 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, AS AMENDED, MAYOR D. The specific subject of the meeting is as follows:

3. CONSIDERATION OF HIRING BRESHAYLA BAPTIST AS A RADIO OPERATOR (DISPATCHER) IN THE STARKVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

**1. CONCESSION TRAILERS**
