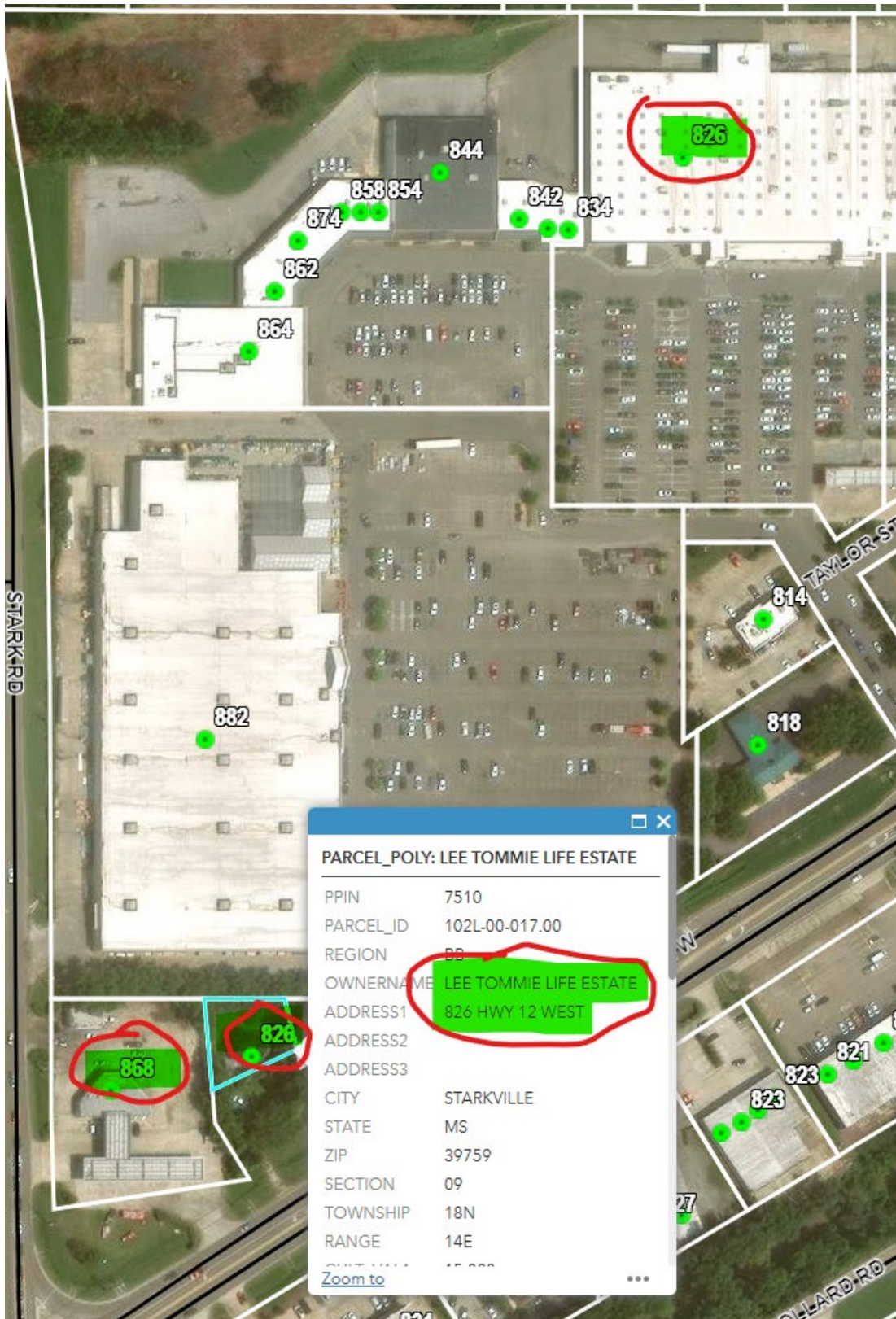

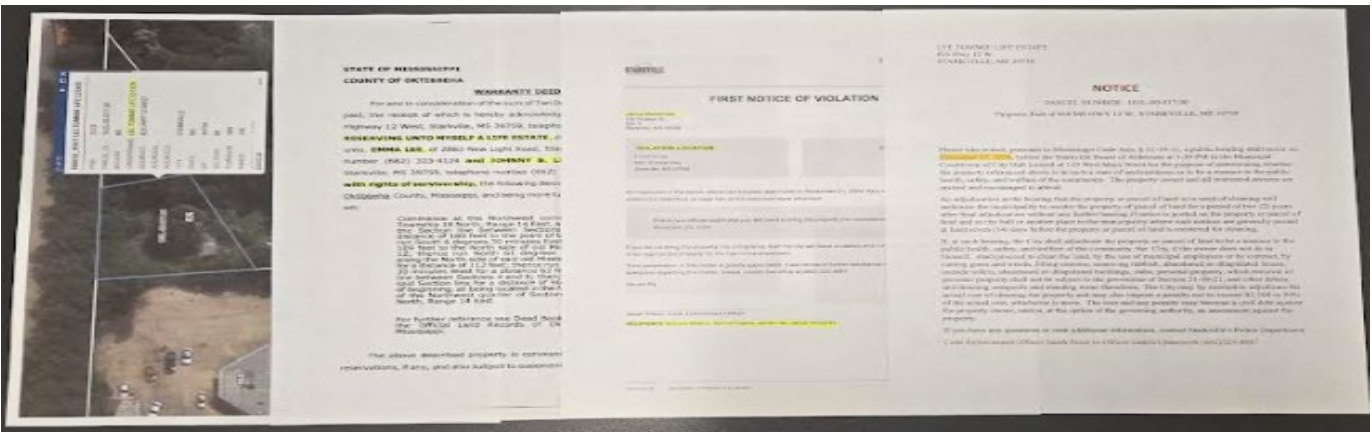

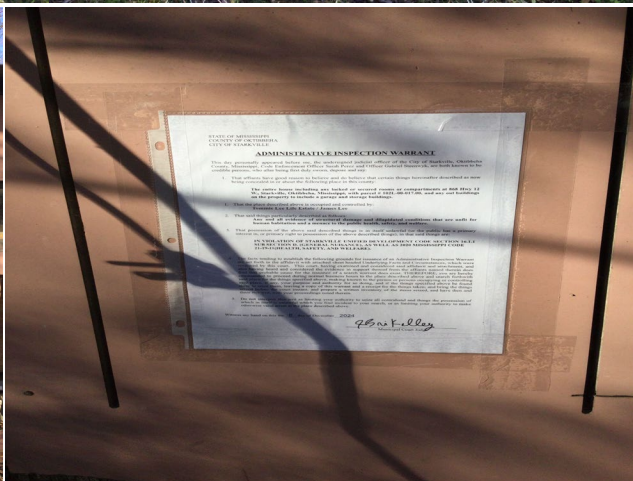

REGIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACT APPLICATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY IN CONNECTION WITH THE INDUCEMENT OF A REGIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
PROJECT AND RELATED MATTERS.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Starkville, Mississippi (the “Mayor” and “Board”, respectively, of the “City”), acting for and on behalf of the City, hereby finds, determines, adjudicates and declares as follows:

1. All references herein to “MCA §” shall mean the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.
2. There has been presented to the Mayor and Board drafts of the following proposed agreements: (a) a Regional Economic Development Act Alliance Agreement – Candlewood Suites Development Project (a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** and is referred to herein as the “REDA Agreement”) by and between Oktibbeha County, Mississippi (the “County”) and the City, and (b) a Development and Reimbursement Agreement - Candlewood Suites Development Project by and between the County, the City and DZP, LLC (a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit “B”** and is referred to herein as the “Project Development Agreement”, and together with the REDA Agreement, the “Project Agreements”);
3. The Mayor and Board hereby adopt and incorporate as their findings, determinations, adjudications and declarations for purposes of this Resolution all of the Recitals set forth in each of the Project Agreements;
4. The Mayor and Board now find and determine that it would be in the best interest of the City and its citizens for the Mayor and Board to approve and execute both of the Project Agreements, authorize the County to submit the REDA Agreement to the Office of the Attorney General of the State for approval, and upon approval of such agreement by the Office of the Attorney General of the State, to perform the City’s obligations pursuant thereto in order to encourage and support the development of the Project, as defined in the Project Development Agreement, as a new suites-style lodging and hospitality establishment in the City and the County; and
5. The Mayor and Board additionally find and determine that it would be in the best interest of the City and its citizens for the Mayor and Board to authorize the County to prepare and submit an application to the Mississippi Development Authority (“MDA”), on the form or forms prescribed thereby, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to authorize the creation of the alliance described in, and pursuant to, the REDA Agreement (the “REDA Application”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Authorization of REDA Application. The Mayor is hereby authorized to prepare and deliver to the MDA the REDA Application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to authorize the creation of the alliance described in, and pursuant to, the REDA Agreement;

SECTION 2. Authorization of Project Agreements. The Project Agreements are hereby approved, and the Mayor and the City Clerk/CFO of the City are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Project Agreements under the seal of the City, for and on behalf of the City, in substantially the forms attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** and **Exhibit “B”**, respectively, with such completions, changes, insertions and modifications as shall be approved by the City Attorney and the Mayor, the approval thereof by the City Attorney and the execution thereof by the Mayor to be conclusive evidence of such approval; all provisions of the Project Agreements, when executed as authorized herein, shall be deemed to be a part of this resolution as fully and to the extent as if separately set out verbatim herein; and in the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and the provisions of the Project Agreements, the provisions of the Project Agreements shall govern. The Mayor and City Clerk/CFO of the City, or the County are each hereby independently authorized, upon the issuance by the MDA of a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the creation of the alliance described in, and pursuant to, the REDA Agreement, to submit the executed REDA Agreement to the Office of the Attorney General of the State for approval thereby of such agreement.

**DEVELOPMENT AND REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT
(CANDLEWOOD SUITES DEVELOPMENT PROJECT)**

This DEVELOPMENT AND REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT (CANDLEWOOD SUITES DEVELOPMENT PROJECT) (this "Agreement") is entered into effective as of December ____, 2024 (the "Effective Date"), by and among the CITY OF STARKVILLE, MISSISSIPPI (the "City"), a municipality organized under the laws of the State of Mississippi (the "State"), OKTIBBEHA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI (the "County"), a Mississippi public body corporate and politic, and DZP Development, LLC, a Mississippi limited liability company ("the "Developer"). The City, the County and the Developer may be referred to herein each as a "Party" or collectively as "Parties."

RECITALS

A. WHEREAS, the Developer develops, owns, and operates lodging and hospitality establishments, and desires to expand the number of its developments in the Southeast United States;

B. WHEREAS, the Developer has entered into a Purchase and Sale Agreement to acquire and own the land located on Hollywood Drive near the intersection of Highways 12 and 25 in the City (County tax map parcel no. 103H-00-016.00) and as more particularly described in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto (such land being referred to herein as the "Property")

C. WHEREAS, the Developer intends to acquire the Property with the objective of materially developing the Property in a series of development phases, including but not limited to (i) constructing a new suites-style hospitality establishment to operate upon the completion thereof as a "Candlewood Suites" hotel, (ii) paving of and improvements to parking areas; and (iii) construction of landscaping and outdoor lighting (collectively, the "Development Project");

D. WHEREAS, the cost of the Development Project is estimated by the Developer to require a capital investment of approximately \$10,000,000 and result in the creation of 15 or more permanent jobs

E. WHEREAS, the entirety of the Development Project lies within the boundaries of the City and the County, is expected by each of the Parties to provide substantial direct and indirect economic development benefits to both the City and the County, as well as the whole of northeast Mississippi, because (i) it will be significantly closer to the City's regional Cornerstone Sports Complex, which routinely hosts multiple statewide and regional youth sports tournaments, than the next nearest lodging and hospitality establishment, and (ii) the suites-style room proposed for the Project are more attractive to families traveling for those youth sports tournaments, thereby enhancing the City's ability to recruit large sports tournaments that drive travel and tourism and the resulting increase in tax revenues in the City, the County and the surrounding region;

F. WHEREAS, to help ensure the Development Project's financial feasibility and success, the Developer and representatives of the City and the County have discussed various forms of incentives and financial assistance utilizing funds generated from the new sales and property taxes resulting from the Development Project; and

G. WHEREAS, the intent of this Agreement is to set forth and memorialize: (i) the incentives offered to the Developer to undertake the Development Project in the City and County in accordance herewith; (ii) the respective roles and responsibilities of the City, the County and the Developer to finance, develop, and construct the various components of the Development Project; and (iii) the timetable for

implementation of the incentives described herein and the financing and construction of the Development Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties do hereby agree as follows:

**ARTICLE I
DEFINITIONS**

1.1 Defined Terms.

(a) "Affiliate" means any business entity that directly or indirectly, through one or more intermediaries, Controls or is Controlled by or is under common Control with the Developer.

(b) "Agreement" has the meaning ascribed to such term in Preamble hereof.

(c) "Applicable Law" means any and all federal, State, County, City and other local laws, rules, regulations, statutes, ordinances, permits, resolutions, judgements, orders, decrees, directives, interpretations, standards, licenses, Governmental Approvals, and similar binding authority, applicable to the Project and/or the performance by the Parties of their respective obligations or the exercise by the Parties of their respective rights in connection with this Agreement, including, without limitation, all Local Laws.

(d) "Business Day" means any day other than a Saturday, a Sunday, or a day on which banks generally and public offices are not open under the laws of the State.

(e) "City" has the meaning ascribed to such term in the Preamble hereof.

(f) "Board of Aldermen" means the Mayor and the board of aldermen of the City.

(g) "City Property Tax Base" means that portion of the total ad valorem taxes allocable to the City's general fund, which are received by the City based on the assessed values of the Property, together with all taxable improvements and personal property located thereon, whether owned by the Developer or any other tenant or occupant of the Property or any portion thereof, for the 2024 ad valorem assessment year.

(h) "City Property Tax Increment" means (1) that portion of the total ad valorem taxes allocable to the City's general fund, which are received by the City based on the assessed values of Property, together with all taxable improvements and personal property located thereon, whether owned by the Developer or any other tenant or occupant of Property or any portion thereof, for each ad valorem assessment year that follows the 2024 ad valorem assessment year, MINUS (2) the City Property Tax Base.

(i) "Developer" has the meaning ascribed to such term in the Preamble hereof.

(j) "Control" (including the correlative meanings of the terms "Controlled by" and "under common Control with" and "Controlling") means with respect to any Person, the possession, directly or indirectly, of the power to direct or cause the direction of the management policies of such Person, whether through the ownership of voting securities or by contract or otherwise.

(k) "County" has the meaning ascribed to such term in the Recitals hereof.

(l) "County Board" means the Board of Supervisors of the County.

(m) "County Property Tax Base" means that portion of the total ad valorem taxes allocable to the County's general fund, which are received by the County based on the assessed values of Property, together with all taxable improvements and personal property located thereon, whether owned by the Developer or any other tenant or occupant of Property or any portion thereof, for the 2024 ad valorem assessment year.

(n) "County Property Tax Increment" means (1) that portion of the total ad valorem taxes allocable to the County's general fund, which are received by the County based on the assessed values of the Property, together with all taxable improvements and personal property located thereon, whether owned by the Developer or any other tenant or occupant of the Property or any portion thereof, for each ad valorem assessment year that follows the 2024 ad valorem assessment year, MINUS (2) the County Property Tax Base.

(o) "Effective Date" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in the Preamble hereof.

(p) "Event of Default" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in Section 7.01 hereof.

(q) "First Payment Date" means the date that is ninety (90) days after the first anniversary of the Project Operation Date.

(r) "Fiscal Year" means a calendar year.

(s) "Force Majeure Event" has the meaning ascribed to such term in Section 9.12 hereof.

(t) "Governmental Approval" means any approval, authorization, consent, waiver, permit, license or certificate required and issued or granted by any Governmental Body having jurisdiction necessary to implement and complete the Project in accordance with Applicable Law and this Agreement.

(u) "Governmental Body" means any federal, state, county or local agency, department, commission, authority, court, or tribunal and any successor thereto, exercising executive, legislative, judicial, or administrative functions of or pertaining to government.

(v) "Improvements" means those improvements to the Property described on **Exhibit "B"** attached hereto.

(w) "Incentive Payment" and "Incentive Payments" have the respective meanings ascribed to such term in Section 5.02.

(x) "LINK" means the Golden Triangle Development LINK, a Mississippi non-profit corporation, which performs economic development services on behalf of the City and the County.

(y) "Local Laws" shall mean all rules, regulations, statutes, ordinances, building codes, permits, resolutions, judgements, orders, decrees, directives, interpretations, standards, licenses, Governmental Approvals, and similar binding authority, of the City and/or the County applicable to the Development Project and/or the performance by the Parties of their respective obligations or the exercise by the Parties of their respective rights in connection with this Agreement.

(z) "Maximum Incentive Amount" means One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000).

(aa) "Mayor" shall mean the mayor of the City.

- (bb) "MCA" shall mean the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.
- (cc) "Notice of Default" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in Section 7.01 hereof.
- (dd) "Party" and "Parties" shall have the respective meanings ascribed to such terms in the Preamble hereof.
- (ee) "Person" shall mean any individual, sole proprietorship, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited liability company or partnership, trust, unincorporated association, institution, public or Governmental Body or any other such entity.
- (ff) "Payment Date" means the First Payment Date and each of the first eleven (11) anniversaries of the First Payment Date.
- (gg) "Planning Division" means the Office of City Planning and Development or Zoning and Inspection Department of the City.
- (hh) "Progress Report" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in Section 4.01.
- (ii) "Progress Meeting" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in Section 4.01.
- (jj) "Project Operation Date" means the date upon which the Developer opens for business and begins operating a hotel at the Property under the brand name "Candlewood Suites"
- (kk) "Project Operation Deadline" means December 31, 2026, subject to any extension for a Force Majeure Event.
- (ll) "RED Act" has the meaning ascribed to such term in Section 5.01 hereof.
- (mm) "Sales Tax Base" means that portion of the total sales taxes derived from retail sales made on the Property for the 2024 Fiscal Year, which are diverted to the City by the State in accordance with applicable law (e.g., currently 18.5% of the total sales taxes generated upon the Property); provided, that such calculation shall exclude any special sales tax levies imposed by the City and/or County for any purpose pursuant to any local and private legislative authority.
- (nn) "Sales Tax Increment" means (1) that portion of the total sales taxes derived from retail sales made on the Property, if any, for each Fiscal Year following the 2024 Fiscal Year, which are diverted to the City by the State in accordance with applicable law (e.g., currently 18.5% of such sales taxes generated upon the Property), MINUS (2) the Sales Tax Base; provided, however, that such calculation set forth in (1) above shall exclude any special sales tax levies imposed by the City and/or County for any purpose pursuant to any local and private legislative authority.
- (oo) "State" means the State of Mississippi.
- (pp) "Term" means the period beginning on the Effective Date hereof and continuing until remittance of the final Incentive Payment unless terminated earlier in accordance with this Agreement.

1.2 Interpretation and Construction. In this Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) The terms "hereby", "hereof", "hereto", "herein", "hereunder" and any similar terms, as used in this Agreement, refer to this Agreement, and the term "hereafter" means after the Effective Date.
- (b) Words importing a particular gender mean and include correlative words of every other gender and words importing the singular number mean and include the plural number and vice versa.
- (c) Unless otherwise noted, the terms "include," "includes" and "including" when used in this Agreement shall be deemed to be followed by the phrase "without limitation."
- (d) Any headings preceding the texts of the several Articles and Sections of this Agreement, and any table of contents or marginal notes appended to copies hereof, shall be solely for convenience of reference and shall not constitute a part of this Agreement, nor shall they affect its meaning, construction or effect. Any references to Articles and Sections in this Agreement shall be deemed to be references to the Articles and Sections in this Agreement except or unless the context or express terms of this Agreement may otherwise provide, specify or dictate.

(e) All notices to be given hereunder and responses thereto shall be given, unless a certain number of days is specified, within a reasonable time, which shall not be less than ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days, unless the context dictates otherwise.

(f) The word "days" as used in this Agreement shall mean calendar days unless a contrary intention is stated, provided that if the final date of any period provided in this Agreement for the performance of an obligation or for the taking of any action falls on a day other than a Business Day, then the time of such period shall be deemed extended to the next Business Day.

(g) Any reference to Applicable Law shall be read to mean as the Applicable Law, as amended from time to time, except where the Developer's obligation to comply was satisfied prior to the amendment.

(h) The recitals hereto contain statements of fact and/or expressions of intention and are incorporated into and made part of the substance of this Agreement.

ARTICLE II DESCRIPTION OF THE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Section 2.01. Development Project Improvements. The Developer shall construct or cause to be constructed the Improvements, as described in **Exhibit "B"** attached hereto.

Section 2.02. Ribbon Cutting. On or about the Project Operation Date, the Developer shall coordinate a ribbon cutting ceremony at the Property, to which the public, the Board of Aldermen, the County Board and the LINK's employees will be invited and at which at least one representative of the Developer, the Mayor, the president of the County Board, and a designee of the LINK, as well as any other Persons agreed upon by the Parties, will be invited to speak. The Parties shall confer and mutually agree upon all details concerning such ribbon cutting ceremony.

ARTICLE III PROCEDURES GOVERNING REVIEW AND APPROVAL FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Section 3.01 Procedures; General. In order to facilitate the development and implementation of the Development Project, the Parties have established the procedures set forth in this Article III for the following review, approval and permitting process. The process shall consist of an application to the Planning Division and the City for review, approval and permitting, as set forth in detail below. The development and construction process shall be conducted in accordance with all Applicable Laws, including all Local Laws. The Developer shall have vested rights to undertake the development of the Property in accordance with such Applicable Laws and this Agreement; and any amendments of, or changes or amendments to, any Local Laws following the Effective Date hereof shall be generally applicable to all such other such commercial projects within the City and shall not be enacted so as to be applicable only to the Property or any portion thereof or to the Development Project or any elements thereof. No provision of this Agreement is intended to restrict the exercise by the Planning Division, the Board of Aldermen, the County Board or of any other governmental authority with respect to applications by the Developer for any approval or building permits under duly adopted rules and regulations or to in any way alter the procedures established for challenging the exercise of such authority pursuant to any Applicable Law. This procedure shall be used for all development applications by the Developer with respect to the Development Project.

Section 3.02. Other Governmental Approvals. It is acknowledged by all Parties that it may be necessary under the Applicable Law for the Developer to obtain Governmental Approvals or permits from other Governmental Bodies in order to undertake the development of the Development Project, as well as building permits for any structures to be demolished or constructed upon the Property and other approvals from the City under the Local Laws. The Developer agrees that it will take all necessary steps to prepare and apply for and proceed diligently to attempt to obtain any needed permits and Governmental Approvals for the Development Project in a timely fashion and utilizing commercially reasonable efforts. The City agrees that all submissions to the City for any Governmental Approvals, including but not limited to building permits, for which the City is responsible for the issuance or granting thereof, shall be processed in accordance with the City's ordinances and procedures.

ARTICLE IV CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT

Section 4.01. Progress Reports and Progress Meetings. Upon request of the City, the County or the LINK, the Developer shall submit to the City, the County and the LINK a report in writing concerning the actual progress of the Developer with respect to the implementation and construction of the Development Project (each such report a "Progress Report"); provided that the Developer shall not be required to provide such Progress Report more than two times each calendar year. Any information provided by the Developer in any such Progress Report which contains trade secrets or confidential commercial or financial information should be clearly marked as "Confidential" as such information is not subject to public inspection, examination, copying or reproduction pursuant to the Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983, as amended. Upon the request of the County or the City, the Developer and any necessary consultants and professionals retained thereby shall meet with the LINK, the County and/or the City, as directed by the County and City, to report on its progress or to address any concerns that the each of the LINK, the County and/or the City has based upon its review of any Progress Report (in each instance, a "Progress Meeting").

Section 4.02. Records Retention. The Developer agrees to maintain separate itemized records of the costs of the Development Project for which the Developer seeks reimbursement via the Incentive Payment. Such records shall be maintained by the Developer in a manner so as to aid the City and the County in accounting for costs eligible for reimbursement under this Agreement and under the RED Act, and shall continue to maintain such records for the duration of the Term. The Developer shall further make such records available to any auditor of the City and/or County. The Developer further agrees that, if an audit is conducted which requires additional records to support the findings of any audit, the Developer will cooperate in providing such additional records to the auditor of the City and/or County, as applicable. The City and County each agree that the cost to engineer, design, construct and/or install the Improvements outlined in **Exhibit "B"** are hereby approved as Development Project expenses that are eligible for reimbursement from one or more Incentive Payments payable to the Developer in accordance herewith in a total amount not to exceed the Maximum Incentive Amount.

Section 4.03. Suspension of Development. Subject to Section 9.12 hereof, if the Developer fails to cause the Project Operation Date to occur on or before the Project Operation Deadline, the County and the City, in their sole discretion, shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon sixty (60) days written notice to the Developer; provided that City's and County's right to terminate this Agreement pursuant to this Section shall lapse if the Project Operation Date occurs prior to the County and/or the City exercising its right to terminate this Agreement pursuant to this Section 4.03.

ARTICLE V

PROJECT INCENTIVES AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY AND THE COUNTY

Section 5.01. RED Act. Although the Developer shall be solely responsible for the Development Project, the City and County, for the purpose of reimbursing up to the Maximum Incentive Amount of such Development Project costs incurred by the Developer in accordance with this Agreement, each agree to adopt such resolutions and take such further actions as may be legally required for them to form a regional economic development alliance pursuant to MCA § 57-64-1 *et seq.* (the "RED Act"), enter into a regional economic development alliance agreement pursuant to the RED Act and apply for and obtain all necessary approvals required from, and make all necessary filings with, the MDA, Office of the Mississippi Attorney General, the Office of the Mississippi Secretary of State and the Office of the County Chancery Clerk to qualify the Development Project as a "project" under the RED Act and to render such alliance agreement effective and enforceable. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement or any other document or agreement previously or subsequently entered into between any of the Parties, the City and County shall have no obligation to provide any Incentive Payments to the Developer unless and until all Governmental Approvals have been obtained to qualify the Development Project as a "project" under the RED Act and the associated alliance agreement between the City and the County has been approved by the Office of the Mississippi Attorney General and filed with the Office of the Mississippi Secretary of State and the Office of the County Chancery Clerk. In the event that the City and the County are unable to obtain all necessary approvals required from, and make all necessary filings with, the MDA, Office of the Mississippi Attorney General, the Office of the Mississippi Secretary of State and the Office of the County Chancery Clerk to qualify the Development Project as a "project" under the RED Act and to render such alliance agreement effective and enforceable within one hundred eighty (180) days following the Effective Date, the Developer may terminate this Agreement anytime thereafter.

Section 5.02 Incentive Payments. Beginning on the First Payment Date, subject to Section 5.03, the City and County shall begin making annual reimbursement payments to the Developer in accordance herewith once per year for a period of twelve (12) years or until the aggregate amount of all such annual reimbursement payments to the Developer equals the Maximum Reimbursement Amount (each such annual payment an "Incentive Payment" and collectively, the "Incentive Payments"), whichever occurs first. Such annual Incentive Payments shall be made subject to the RED Act and only to reimburse the Developer for any "costs of the project" as such term is defined in the RED Act, with the term "project" in the RED Act referring to the Project, as defined herein.

- (a) Each annual Incentive Payment due from the City to the Developer shall equal (i) fifty percent (50%) of the amount of the Sales Tax Increment for the preceding Fiscal Year, plus (ii) one hundred percent (100%) of the City Property Tax Increment for such preceding Fiscal Year.
- (b) Each annual Incentive Payment due from the County to the Developer shall equal one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the County Property Tax Increment for such preceding Fiscal Year.
- (c) Each annual Incentive Payment shall be due and payable to the Developer on or before each Payment Date.
- (d) Notwithstanding the forgoing, the City and the County shall have no obligation to make any further Incentive Payments to the Developer in excess of the Maximum Incentive Amount; nor shall the City or the County have any obligation to make more than twelve (12) annual incentive Payments to the Developer or to make any Incentive Payments to the Developer for periods accruing after the Term hereof; provided, however, that any obligation of the City and County to make any final Incentive Payment payable to the Developer for any period accruing prior to the expiration of the Term shall survive such expiration of this Agreement.

Section 5.03. Mississippi Department of Revenue Reporting. Within thirty (30) days following the Project Operation Date and each of the successive eleven (11) anniversaries thereof, the Developer shall provide the City with such consents and authorizations as may be required by the Mississippi Department of Revenue for it to provide to the City the requisite sales tax information required to determine the Sales Tax Increment for the applicable period. Notwithstanding any other provision of this

Agreement to the contrary, including but not limited the provisions of Section 5.02, the City shall have no obligation to remit an Incentive Payment to the Developer until thirty (30) days following receipt by the City from the Mississippi Department of Revenue of the requisite sales tax information required to determine the Sales Tax Increment for the applicable period; provided that the City shall, subject to the Developer's timely compliance with its obligation is under this Section, use its commercially reasonable best efforts to request and obtain such information from Mississippi Department of Revenue within sixty (60) days after the Project Operation Date and each of the successive eleven (11) anniversaries thereof.

ARTICLE VI

REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES AND COVENANTS

Section 6.01. The Developer's Representations, Warranties and Covenants. The Developer hereby represents and warrants to, and covenants with the City and the County that:

(a) Organization. The Developer is a limited liability company duly formed, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of the State of Mississippi with all requisite power and authority to enter into this Agreement.

(b) Authorization; No Violation. The execution, delivery and performance by the Developer of this Agreement has been duly authorized by all necessary action and will not violate the articles of incorporation, bylaws, shareholder agreement or any other formation or operating document of the Developer or constitute an Event of Default under any loan or credit agreement to which it is a Party, or other material agreement to which the Developer is a Party or by which the Developer may be bound or affected.

(c) Valid and Binding Obligations. The Person executing this Agreement on behalf of the Developer has been duly authorized and empowered and this Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by the Developer and constitutes the valid and binding obligation of the Developer.

(d) Litigation. No suit is pending against the Developer which could have a material adverse effect upon the Developer's performance under this Agreement or the financial condition or business of the Developer. There are no outstanding judgments against Developer that would have a material adverse effect upon the Developer or which would materially impair or limit of the ability of the Developer to enter into or carry out the transactions contemplated by this Agreement.

(e) No Conflicts. This Agreement is not prohibited by and does not conflict with any other agreements, instruments, judgments or decrees to which the Developer is a Party or is otherwise subject.

(f) No Violation of Laws. As of the Effective Date, the Developer has not received any notices asserting any noncompliance in any material respect by the Developer with applicable statutes, rules and regulations of the United States, the State of Mississippi or of any agency having jurisdiction over and with respect to the transactions contemplated in and by this Agreement, which would have a material adverse effect on the Developer's ability to perform its obligations under this Agreement. The Developer is not in default with respect to any judgment, order, injunction or decree of any court, administrative agency, or other Governmental Body which is in any respect material to the transactions contemplated hereby.

(g) Qualifications of the Developer. The Developer is experienced and qualified to undertake the responsibilities and perform the work provided for in, or contemplated under, this Agreement and it is properly equipped, organized and in good financial standing so as to perform all such work and undertake all such responsibilities hereunder.

(h) Bankruptcy. No receiver, liquidator, custodian or trustee of the Developer shall have been appointed as of the Effective Date, and no petition to reorganize the Developer pursuant to the United States Bankruptcy Code or any similar statute that is applicable to the Developer shall have been filed as of the Effective Date. No adjudication of bankruptcy of Developer or a filing for voluntary bankruptcy by the Developer under the provisions of the United States Bankruptcy Code or any other similar statute that is applicable to the Developer shall have been filed.

(i) Reasonable Efforts to Complete. The Developer shall use all commercially reasonable efforts to cause the Project Operation Date to occur on or prior to the Project Operation Deadline.

Section 6.02. The City's Representations, Warranties and Covenants.

(a) Organization. The City is a public body corporate and politic duly organized under the laws of the State of Mississippi. The City has all requisite power and authority to enter into this Agreement.

(b) Authorization; No Violation. The execution, delivery and performance by the City of this Agreement are within the authority of the City under, and will not violate, the statutes, rules and regulations establishing the City and governing its activities, have been duly authorized by all necessary resolutions and/or ordinances.

(c) Valid and Binding Obligations. The Person executing this Agreement on behalf of the City has been duly authorized by Resolution to execute this Agreement, has been duly executed and delivered by the City and constitutes the valid and binding obligation of the City.

(d) Litigation. No suit is pending against or affects the City which could have a material adverse effect upon the City's performance under this Agreement. There are no outstanding judgments against the City that would have a material adverse effect upon the City or which would materially impair or limit of the ability of the City to enter into or carry out the transactions contemplated by this Agreement.

(e) No Conflicts. This Agreement is not prohibited by and does not conflict with any other agreements,

instruments, judgments or decrees to which the City is a Party or is otherwise subject.

(f) No Violation of Laws. As of the Effective Date, the City has not received any notices from any public agency asserting any noncompliance in any material respect by the City with applicable statutes, rules and regulations of the United States of America, the State of Mississippi or any other public agency having jurisdiction over and with respect to the transactions contemplated in and by this Agreement which would have a material adverse effect on the City's ability to perform its obligations under this Agreement. The City is not in default with respect to any judgment, order, injunction or decree of any court, administrative agency, or other governmental authority which is in any respect material to the transactions contemplated hereby. The City shall comply with all Applicable Law in fulfilling its obligations under this Agreement.

(g) Sale Tax Base. As of the Effective Date, the Sales Tax Base is \$0.00.

Section 6.03. The County's Representations, Warranties and Covenants.

(a) Organization. The County is a public body corporate and politic existing under the laws of the State of Mississippi. The County has all requisite power and authority to enter into this Agreement.

(b) Authorization; No Violation. The execution, delivery and performance by the County of this Agreement are within the authority of the County under, and will not violate, the statutes, rules and regulations establishing the County and governing its activities, have been duly authorized by all necessary resolutions and/or ordinances.

(c) Valid and Binding Obligations. The Person executing this Agreement on behalf of the County has been duly authorized by Resolution to execute this Agreement, has been duly executed and delivered by the County and constitutes the valid and binding obligation of the County.

(d) Litigation. No suit is pending against or affects the County which could have a material adverse effect upon the County's performance under this Agreement. There are no outstanding judgments against the County that would have a material adverse effect upon the County or which would materially impair or limit of the ability of the County to enter into or carry out the transactions contemplated by this Agreement.

(e) No Conflicts. This Agreement is not prohibited by and does not conflict with any other agreements, instruments, judgments or decrees to which the County is a Party or is otherwise subject.

(f) No Violation of Laws. As of the Effective Date, the County has not received any notices from any public agency asserting any noncompliance in any material respect by the County with applicable statutes, rules and regulations of the United States of America, the State of Mississippi or any other public agency having jurisdiction over and with respect to the transactions contemplated in and by this Agreement which would have a material adverse effect on the County's ability to perform its obligations under this Agreement. The County is not in default with respect to any judgment, order, injunction or decree of any court, administrative agency, or other governmental authority which is in any respect material to the transactions contemplated hereby. The County shall comply with all Applicable Law in fulfilling its obligations under this Agreement.

(g) No Governmental Approvals. As of the Effective Date, there are no Governmental Approvals required by the County to complete the Project as described herein.

**ARTICLE VII
DEFAULT**

Section 7.01. Events of Default. Failure of any Party to observe or perform in any material respect any covenant, condition, representation, obligation, warranty or agreement hereunder, and any act or omission characterized elsewhere in this Agreement as an Event of Default, subject to the provisions hereof, and the continuance of such failure, act or omission for a period of thirty (30) days after receipt by the defaulting Party of written notice from the non-defaulting Party specifying the nature of such failure and requesting that such failure, act or omission be remedied (a "Notice of Default") shall constitute an event of default (each an "Event of Default") by the applicable Party.

Section 7.02. Developer's Remedies. If either the City or the County shall fail to timely remit to the Developer any Incentive Payment due thereto in accordance with this Agreement, the Developer may elect any or all of the following remedies following such failure: (i) to terminate this Agreement by providing a Notice of Default to the City and County in accordance with the applicable notice provisions of this Agreement; (ii) to seek monetary damages for the Maximum Incentive Amount minus the total amount of Incentive Payments received; and (iii) to seek any other remedies available to it at law or equity. To the extent permitted by Applicable Law, the City and County shall further be responsible for all collection costs, attorneys' fees and court costs incurred in collecting Incentive Payment(s) from the City and/or County.

Section 7.03 No Waiver of Rights and Remedies by Delay. Any delay by an aggrieved Party in instituting or prosecuting any actions or proceedings or otherwise asserting its rights under this Agreement shall not operate as a waiver of such rights and shall not deprive the aggrieved Party of or limit the aggrieved Party's rights in any way (it being the intent of this provision that the aggrieved Party should not be constrained so as to avoid the risk of being deprived or limited in the exercise of the remedies provided herein by those concepts of waiver, laches, or otherwise) to exercise such rights at a time when, the aggrieved Party may still resolve the problems by the Event of Default involved; nor shall any waiver in fact made by the aggrieved Party with respect to any specific Event of Default by the other Party under this Agreement be considered or treated as a waiver of the rights of the aggrieved Party with respect to any other Event of Default by the other Party under this Agreement or with respect to the particular Event of Default except to the extent specifically waived in writing.

Section 7.04. Rights and Remedies Cumulative. The rights and remedies of the Parties set forth in this Agreement, whether provided by Applicable Laws or by this Agreement, shall be cumulative and, except as otherwise specifically provided by this Agreement, the exercise by any Party of any one or more of such remedies shall not preclude the exercise by it, at the same or different times, of any other such remedies for the same Event of Default or of any of its remedies for any other Event of Default by the other Parties. No waiver made by either such Party with respect to the performance, or manner or time thereof, or any obligation of the other Parties or any condition to their own obligations under the Agreement shall be considered a waiver of any rights of the Party making the waiver with respect to the particular obligation of the other Parties or condition to their own obligations beyond those expressly waived in writing and to the extent thereof, or a waiver in any respect in regard to any other rights of the Party making the waiver or any other obligations of the other Parties. To the fullest extent permitted by Applicable Law, no Party hereto shall be liable to another Party hereto for any indirect, special, consequential or punitive damages or amounts for losses of income, profits or savings arising out of or relating to the performance or failure by a Party hereto to perform its obligations under this Agreement.

**ARTICLE VIII
NOTICES AND DEMANDS**

Section 8.01. Notices. Any notice, demand or other communication made pursuant to this Agreement by any Party to another Party shall be deemed sufficiently given or delivered three (3) days following the dispatch thereof by United States Registered or Certified Mail, postage prepaid and return receipt requested, or if delivered by national overnight courier with delivery confirmation, or if delivered personally (with written acknowledgment of receipt) to the Parties at the following respective addresses or facsimile numbers:

Either Party may from time to time by written notice given to the other pursuant to the terms of this Section 8.01 change the address, facsimile number or persons to which notices shall be sent.

**ARTICLE IX
MISCELLANEOUS**

Section 9.01. No Third-Party Beneficiaries. The provisions of this Agreement are for the exclusive benefit of the Parties hereto and not for the benefit of any third person, nor shall this Agreement be deemed to have conferred any rights, express or implied, upon any third person.

Section 9.02. Amendment; Waiver. No alteration, amendment or modification hereto shall be valid unless executed by an instrument in writing by the Parties to this Agreement with the same formality as this Agreement, including any approval requiring a resolution of the Developer, the City and/or the County. The failure by any Party hereto to insist in any one or more instances upon the strict performance of any of the covenants, agreements, terms, provisions or conditions of this Agreement or to exercise any election contained in this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment for the future of such covenant, agreement, term, provision, condition, election or option, but the same shall continue and remain in full force and effect. No waiver by any Party hereto of any covenant, agreement, term, provision or condition of this Agreement shall be deemed to have been made unless expressed in writing and signed by an appropriate official on behalf of the Party purporting to grant such waiver.

Section 9.03. Consents. Unless otherwise specifically provided herein, no consent or approval by any Party permitted or required under the terms hereof shall be valid or be of any force whatsoever unless the same shall be in writing, signed by an authorized representative of the Party by or on whose behalf such consent is given.

Section 9.04. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi, without giving effect to any principle of choice of or conflicts of laws. Any lawsuit filed by any Party to this Agreement shall be filed in either the Circuit Court or the Chancery Court of Oktibbeha County, Mississippi, as appropriate based upon the jurisdiction of each such court.

Section 9.05. Severability. If any Article, Section, subsection, term or provision of this Agreement or the application thereof to any Party or circumstance shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the Section, subsection, term or provision of this Agreement or the application of same to the Parties or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid or unenforceable shall not be affected thereby and each remaining Article, Section, subsection, term or provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law, provided that no such severance shall serve to deprive any Party of the enjoyment of its substantial benefits under this Agreement.

Section 9.06. Binding Effect. Except as may otherwise be provided in this Agreement to the contrary, this Agreement and each of the provisions hereof shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of each of the Parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

Section 9.07. Relationship of Parties. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be deemed or construed by the Parties hereto or by any third Party to create the relationship of principal and agent, partnership, joint venture or any association between the Developer and the City and/or the County, their relationship being solely as contracting Parties under this Agreement.

Section 9.08. Counterparts and Facsimile Signatures. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which, when taken together, shall be deemed to be one agreement. This Agreement may be executed pursuant to original, electronic, or facsimile copies of signatures, with the same effect as if the Parties had signed the document pursuant to original signature.

Section 9.9. Prior Agreements Superseded. This Agreement supersedes any prior understanding or written or oral agreements (express or implied) between the Parties respecting the Development Project and/or the Property in any context. This Agreement, together with any other documents executed by the Parties contemporaneously herewith or therewith, contains the entire understanding between the Parties with respect thereto.

Section 9.10. Exhibits and Schedules. All Exhibits referred to herein shall be considered a part of this Agreement as fully and with the same force and effect as if such Exhibits had been included within the text of this Agreement in full.

Section 9.11. Construction. Each of the Parties acknowledges that this Agreement has been extensively negotiated with the assistance of competent counsel for each Party and agree that no provision of this Agreement shall be construed in favor of or against any one Party by virtue of the fact that such Party or its counsel have provided an initial or any subsequent draft of this Agreement or of any portion hereto.

Section 9.12 Force Majeure. For purposes of this Section 9.12 and any other obligations of any Party set forth in this Agreement which may be delayed due to a Force Majeure Event, a "Force Majeure Event" means any of the following, which are beyond the reasonable control of such Party, could not reasonably have been foreseen thereby as of the Effective Date and the effects of which could not reasonably have been avoided or overcome by such Party: act of God, labor strike, work stoppage or slow-downs, riots, sabotage, war, terrorist act, epidemic, pandemic, quarantine, governmental executive order, civil or military commotion or disturbance, nuclear or natural catastrophes, environmental contamination not caused or permitted to be caused by such Party, governmental orders, acts or omissions, changes in laws or regulations, fire, explosion, earthquake, hurricane or tropical depression, generalized lack of availability of raw materials, equipment, energy or other utilities and any other causes, whether of the kind herein enumerated or otherwise, not within the control of such Party and which by the exercise of due diligence, such Party is or would have been unable to prevent or overcome and which has a material adverse effect on the performance of such Party's obligations herein. Should any Party claim the inability to perform an obligation based upon a Force Majeure Event, then such Party shall promptly notify the other Parties

of the facts supporting such claim, the obligations affected by the alleged Force Majeure Event, the anticipated delay in performance and the actions being undertaken by such Party claiming the Force Majeure Event to minimize the harm to the other Parties. Where the effects of a Force Majeure Event are temporary, any associated delay in the performance by a Party hereto of its obligations hereunder shall apply only as long as the duration of the specific Force Majeure Event(s) for which notice was provided to the other Parties prevents performance by the Party claiming a Force Majeure Event of its obligations hereunder. The Party claiming a Force Majeure Event shall notify the other Parties hereto as soon as the specific Force Majeure Event(s) for which notice was provided ceases to impede performance of its obligations hereunder. The Party claiming a Force Majeure Event is required to take all reasonable measures to limit the effect of the Force Majeure Event(s) upon performance of such Party's obligations under this Agreement. For clarification and avoidance of confusion, interruptions, delays, suspension, or other adverse impacts to the performance by any Party hereto of its obligations under this Agreement arising from or related to COVID-19 other than (i) a government mandated shutdown and/or (ii) governmental requirements implemented after the Effective Date, which are beyond the control of such Party and that make the performance by such Party of its obligations hereunder impossible or commercially impractical, shall not constitute a Force Majeure Event, and shall not give rise to a claim for relief under this Section. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City and/or County shall not claim a Force Majeure Event for failure to pay any Incentive Payment payable pursuant to Section 5.02 of this Agreement on or before each Payment Date.
