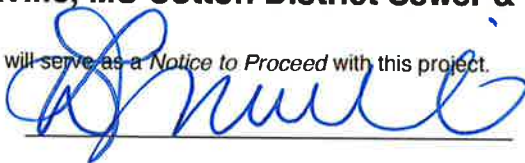

Code Enforcement Supervisor Sgt. Scotty Carrithers presented 135 Sand Rd., Apt 17, Starkville, MS, with Parcel Number 105B-00-001.02. The initial inspection on May 15, 2025 provided evidence that the property contained conditions not suitable for public health and safety such as possible fire damage to the structure. This is causing many issues for the neighboring properties, such as the appearance of the neighborhood and the vacant apartment providing a habitat for wildlife that can pose a threat to people living in the area, and the overall upkeep of the property being neglected. Further investigation provided information that the residence caught fire on June 22, 2024.

A second inspection of the property was conducted on June 10, 2025 by Sergeant Scotty Carrithers. This inspection provided information that the condition of the property has not improved since the initial inspection. Photographs of the property were taken of the property from the right of way. Notices of the Public Hearing were posted on the front entrance window at City Hall and on the property on June 17, 2025. A Notice of Public Hearing was mailed on June 17, 2025, to the property tax payer/owner, Sandhill Arms LLC. Tax payer/owner information was obtained through the Oktibbeha County Chancery Court.

An Administrative Inspection Warrant was served on June 23, 2025, at approximately 11:30 a.m. The warrant was served by Sergeant Scotty Carrithers and Building Official Stein McMullen. Photographs were taken of the property, exterior, and interior of the building structure. When leaving the property, Sergeant Carrithers and Mr. McMullen both noticed that they were both covered in fleas.

Hassell Wilkenson of Century Construction was present and represented Sandhill Arms, LLC. He stated they were attempting to secure funding from MS HomeCore to make improvements to the apartments and that Murphree Paving had been contacted as to parking lot repairs. The Mayor and Board stressed the need for the apartments to be maintained and cleaned.

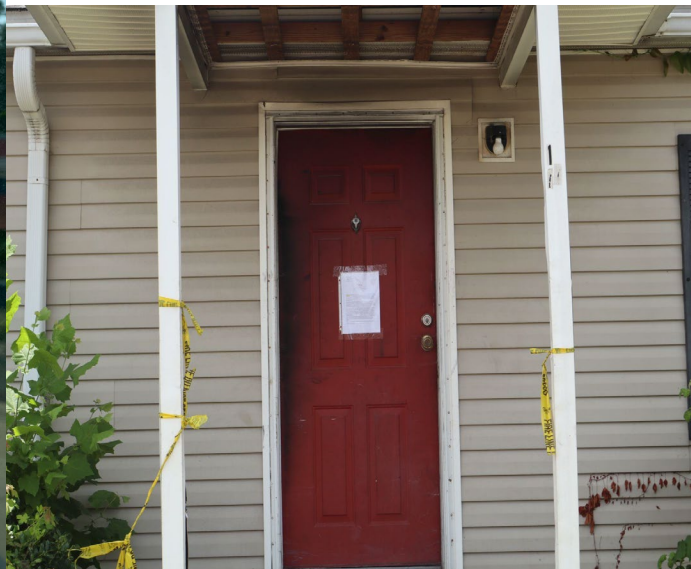
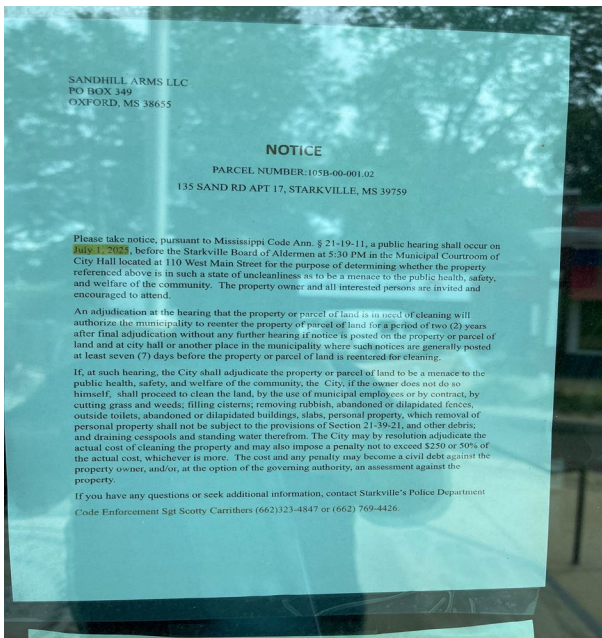

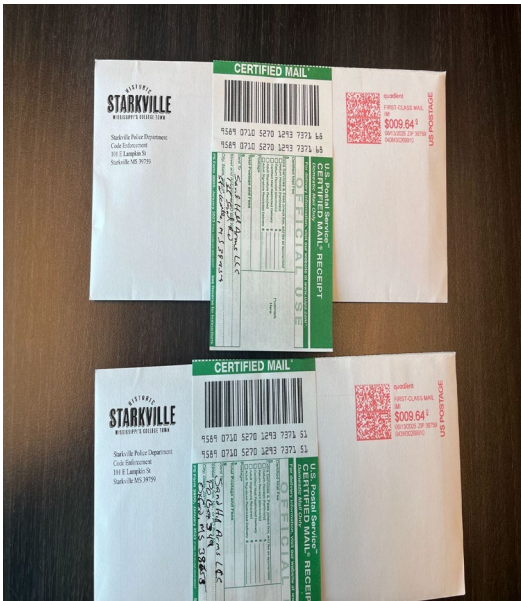
